We offer weeklong adventure camps for children 6-16 to expose them to the great outdoors and natural beauty of South Carolina and to educate them in environmental education and conservation. Skills such as canoeing, fishing, swimming, camping, fire making, gun safety, and hunting ethics in addition to environmental classes in wildlife studies, water quality and stewardship of our natural resources are offered at each session.
